Once a Cold War Era Air Force installation, the Griffiss Business and Technology Park has been transformed into a regional high-tech employment center. It is within a day's drive of one third the United States' economy and more than half the Canadian economy.

Griffiss is currently home to more than 70 employers consisting of national and local technology firms that are directly involved with the Air Force Research Laboratory – a \$1.4 billion economic and research engine at the center of the Park. Additionally, Griffiss is home to the UAS Test Site, which is one of seven FAA designated test sites in the United States.




The Region Mohawk Valley

This region is the geographic center of Upstate New York along the Erie Canal, including the historic urban centers of Utica, Rome, and Amsterdam. It is within 100 miles of major markets in every direction including Albany (90 miles), Syracuse (50 miles), Binghamton (80 miles), and the Canadian border (100 miles).

The Mohawk Valley is a unique mix of pastoral beauty and urban amenities, contributing to a rich diversity of culture and lifestyles. The popularity of home-grown arts, professional sports, craft food & beverages, and adventure tourism make the Mohawk Valley a globally-recognized destination for families, visitors, and talent.

The region is home to numerous academic and research institutions. Flourishing industry clusters include distribution, materials processing, industrial machinery and services, agriculture, craft food and beverage manufacturing, cybersecurity & information assurance, back-office, and financial services. The Utica-Rome MSA's largest employment quotient is in the fields of primary and secondary metals manufacturing (more than 6x the national average) rivaling historical powerhouses like Detroit and Wichita.
